

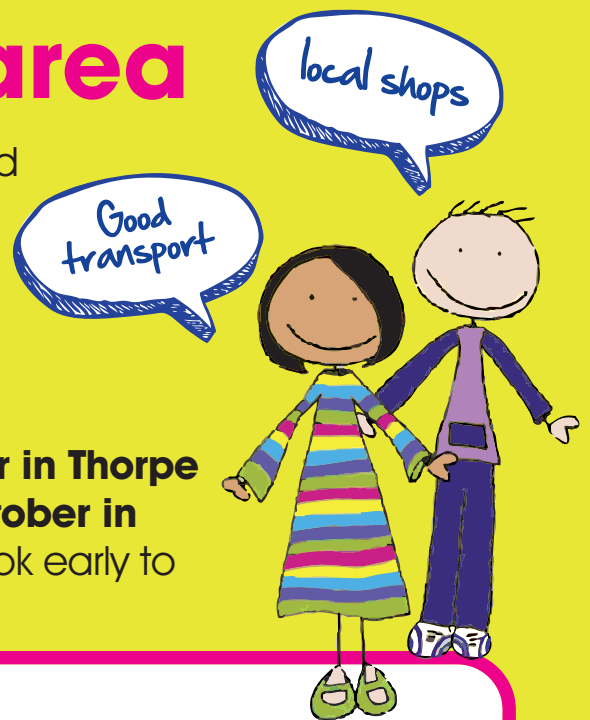
Workshops:
