



16½ MILE CYCLE TOUR

Around Foulsham

Directions

This 16½-mile tour around part of Broadland begins in Foulsham. Foulsham is approximately 18 miles northwest of Norwich just off the A1067 towards Fakenham.

1. At the water tower, take the road into Foulsham passing the village sign on the right. Stay on the same road through the village.
2. After the church, turn right at the next staggered crossroads.
3. Turn left and follow the road for 1½ miles.
4. At the Old Station House, turn left, signed Guestwick. Continue through Guestwick Green. When the road bends sharp right, continue straight ahead, signed Hindolveston.
5. Turn right at Abbey Farm and at the end of this road turn right signed Foulsham. At the junction continue straight ahead, signed Foulsham. A little further on, to the right, is the Parish Church of St Peter.
6. Turn left just past the church signed Salle and continue along this road for 2½ miles.
7. Take the second right turn, signed Themelthorpe, just after Primrose Farm and at the end of this road turn left. Follow through pretty countryside and over the small river bridge. Go over the bridge over the Marriott's Way.
8. Continue on this road for almost a mile turning left again at its end, signed Reepham. At the end of this road turn left signed Reepham, follow the road through attractive

Hackford Vale and uphill into Reepham.

9. Turn right at the crossroads signed Whitwell. However, there is much of interest to see in Reepham town centre and market place which is straight ahead at the crossroads.
10. Continue for about one mile passing under the railway bridge of the Marriott's Way and turn immediately right.
11. At the crossroads turn right and continue for ¾ mile passing the early 19th-century Hackford Hall set in woodland on the left.
12. At the crossroads continue straight ahead, and then keep left on the same road. Continue towards Themelthorpe where the road bends sharp right into the village.
13. Stay on this road going over the old railway bridge. The road bends to the left, signed Foulsham, and continues for 1½ miles. Continue along this road and it will bring you back into the village of Foulsham and the start of the tour.
