



15½ MILE CYCLE TOUR Around Drayton

Directions

This 15½ mile tour begins in Drayton approximately 1½ miles north west of Norwich on the A1067 Norwich to Fakenham Road. When you reach Drayton take the right turn in front of the Red Lion Public House into School Road.

1. Just past the pub on the left is a small parking area and this is where the tour begins.
2. Turn left at the mini-roundabout signed Felthorpe.
3. Continue along this road out into the countryside and at the junction turn left.
4. After about a mile and at the next crossroads turn right, signed Felthorpe. Continue along this lane towards Felthorpe.
5. At the end of the road turn right, signed Horsford and at the staggered crossroads go straight ahead into Shortthorn Road.
6. Continue for a further 2 miles through wooded areas and at the next crossroads again go straight ahead into Parish Road. Follow the road over the bridge and into the village.
7. Continue along this road to find the parish Church of St Margaret's. If you wish to visit the church, follow the road around to the left. If not, turn right on the left bend, signed Hainford, into Hainford Road.
8. At the end of this road, by the early 18th-century Hainford Chequers Public House, turn right, signed Norwich and then immediately left, signed Hainford.

9. Immediately after the church, turn left into Dumbs Lane signed Frettenham and continue through Hainford passing the village sign on the left and the entrance to Hainford Hall.

10. Follow this road for a further 1½ miles and at its end turn right. Continue for ¾ mile over the bridge and stream called the Hor. Follow the road uphill towards Spixworth.

11. Take the right turn directly opposite the church, signed St Peter's and continue for 1½ miles.

12. At the end of the road turn left, signed Norwich. Continue on this road out of the village.

13. At the main road junction turn left then immediately right, signed Church Street.

14. At the end of this road go straight ahead into Drayton Lane and continue for approximately a mile, going straight ahead at the next crossroads towards Drayton.

15. At the junction turn right, signed Costessey into Hall Lane. This road will take you back into Drayton village and to the start of the tour.
