4. DELIVERY OF NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination papers must be delivered during normal office hours (9.00am and 5.00pm) on any working day after the date of this notice, but not later than **4pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019**, to the RETURNING OFFICER, BROADLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL, THORPE LODGE, 1 YARMOUTH ROAD, THORPE ST ANDREW, NORWICH NR7 0DU.

5. POLL

If the election in respect any ward is contested, the poll will take place on **THURSDAY, 2 MAY 2019**.

6. ABSENT VOTES

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, BROADLAND DISTRICT COUNCIL, THORPE LODGE, 1 YARMOUTH ROAD, THORPE ST ANDREW, NORWICH, NR7 0DU **by 5pm on Monday 15 April 2019** if they are to be effective for this election. Applications for a proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019**.

New applications to vote by emergency proxy on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work reasons must be received by not later than **5pm, Thursday, 2 May 2019**. To be able to apply for an emergency proxy vote, the physical incapacity or work commitment must have occurred after **5pm on 24 April 2019**.
