

Electoral Arrangements Committee

Terms of Reference

To oversee Community Governance Reviews, and in particular:

- To approve Terms of Reference for Community Governance Reviews
- Approve draft proposals for public consultation
- Make recommendations to Council on Community Governance Orders, taking into account any feedback received

To oversee the progression of Boundary Commission Reviews across the District, to include Parliamentary, District and Parish boundaries.

To oversee the statutory review of Polling Districts and Polling Places in relation to Parliamentary, District and Parish elections.

Membership

The Committee shall have a membership of eight members.

Quorum

The minimum number of Members to transact any business shall be three.

Procedures, protocols and public speaking

Except as provided below, the Chairman shall be responsible for maintaining order and the effective conduct of business at meetings.

Any Member of the Council can attend and may speak on any issue.

Members of the press and public may attend. General arrangements for public speaking apply.

Voting

Voting at meetings is by show of hands.

Voting Members may request that their votes are recorded.

In the event of an equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote.
